

New EyeDetect Multi-issue Comparison Test Released

EyeDetect has achieved yet another scientific breakthrough!

to accurately detect deception by measuring involuntary eye behavior. In 2019, we announced the release of the 15-minute Directed Lie Comparison (DLC) test, which is a diagnostic test protocol often used in criminal investigations or civil cases. This month Converus released another testing protocol: Multi-issue Comparison Test (MCT).

EyeDetect hit the market in 2014 as the first lie detector screening test



that caused test failure. EyeDetect's ability to tie an examinee's failure to a specific target issue will be a huge boon to credibility assessment experts and organizations. Here's why...

Organizations can now test and score up to four relevant issues and accurately identify the issue

Organizations such as law enforcement often screen job applicants with one test for multiple issues such as drug use, commission of serious crimes, withholding of pertinent backgroundcheck information on the job application, or withholding information about disciplinary action.

These issues have varying degrees of severity. Knowing why the examinee failed enables the

organization to probe deeper as opposed to immediately disqualifying the applicant.

With additional data from the MCT testing protocol, organizations can probe examinees further with polygraph, post-test interviews, and/or an EyeDetect DLC test that focuses on the single issue for which the person failed. For example, if in the post-test interview the examinee reveals a one-time use of a minor drug, a follow-up DLC test could confirm the candidate's statement


