COMMON RELEVANT TOPICS

WHAT IS A RELEVANT TOPIC?

A relevant topic is one related to an act or target behavior of primary concern. Relevant questions should comply with the following guidelines:

- Focus on specific actions or behaviors
- Focus on the examinee's own experience and actions, not those of others
- Be clear and concise (objective, not subjective)
- Use specific time frames to narrow the scope
- Consider if pre-test admissions have been made
- Do not ask about intent, desires or emotions
- Do not use accusatory or assuming language
- Do not use legal, emotionally charged or judgmental terms
- Ensures test topics are distinct and different no crossover

PRE-EMPLOYMENT SCREENING

- Using illegal drugs within the past "x" years
- Using illegal drugs during a specific time frame (i.e., Last year, From January to April, etc.)
- Committing a serious crime act as an adult
- Sexual contact with...
- Committing an act of domestic violence
- Scamming
- Stealing cash, merchandise, equipment, raw materials, etc. worth more than "X"
- Stealing from a previous employer (items worth more than "x")
- Unreported disciplinary action (terminated, suspended, written warning) at a previous job
- Divulging confidential information at a previous employer
- Accept or offer bribes at a previous employer
- Committing fraud at a previous employer

EMPLOYEE SCREENING

INVESTIGATIONS

*THESE ARE SPECIFIC TO THE CASE FACTS, ALLEGATIONS, OR KNOWN INCIDENT

- Sexual contact with that child
- Hearing that woman say "no" or "stop" while engaged in sex
- Inflicting that head injury on that child
- Choking that woman
- Kicking *that woman* in the stomach
- Stealing any of the ... money, product, jewelry, computers, etc. reported missing
- Stabbing that man
